

lethodolog Overview

- The index is derived from the constituents of the BSE 100. The inclusion of DVRs in the index will result in more than 30 stocks in the index. However, the number of companies in the index remains fixed at 30.
- • Stocks must have a listing history of at least six months at BSE and must have a derivative contract.
- • The stock must have traded on every trading day at BSE during the six-month reference period.
